


Recording a Rescue

Please note that the rescue form contains a large number of fields. Only the first two (2) are compulsory (the date/time of the report, and the animal group), however the more information that is able to be captured, the more useful the report will be. It is understood however, that not all fields will be relevant to every rescue, and sometimes not all relevant information will be known.

The date/time of the report can either be typed or completed by pressing the calendar icon and selecting the date/time (Approximate time is fine)





Most rescues will only relate to a single animal. However, if multiple were rescued, the add button can be used to create additional animal records. If you do enter the details of an animal, the species field is compulsory, but all known details should be entered



Provided a valid email address is held for the member conducting the rescue, an email will be sent within a few minutes, confirming details of the rescue, and providing links to update animal details or transfer the animal to a new carer.
